Delaware Road bridge over U.S. 169 to be repaired

The week of Jan. 15 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to start a bridge rail repair project on the Delaware (Tank Farm) Road bridge at the U.S. 169/Delaware Road interchange in Allen County.

A section of the bridge rail was damaged in a crash in 2017. Two-way traffic will be maintained on the bridge at a reduced speed limit of 35 miles per hour. There are no restrictions on U.S. 169 traffic underneath the bridge. Weather permitting, the bridge work should be finished by early spring.
