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## Joint repair project to begin at Coffeyville

Monday, Jan. 5, weather permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin an emergency expansion joint repair on the eastbound lanes of the U.S. 166 railroad overpass at the west edge of Coffeyville.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$36,952 to Mission Construction Company, Inc., of St. Paul, Kan. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction at the work zone and a directional arrow board will be used. No significant delays are expected. The road work should be finished in two weeks, weather permitting.
