Fort Scott sidewalk project to start June 12

Monday, June 12, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to start a Safe Routes to School project that will reconstruct sidewalks and make pedestrian improvements along several streets in Fort Scott.

The sidewalk locations:

- 10th Street, from Horton east to Holbrook;
- 10th Street, from Eddy east to Crawford;
- Holbrook Street, from 10th continuing north;
- Crawford Street, from 12th north to 10th;
- 10th Street, from Crawford east to National;
- Margrave Street, from 4th north to 3rd;
- Margrave Street, from 3rd north to 1st;
- Barbee Street, from 3rd north to 2nd;
- Barbee Street, from 2nd north to Wall;
- Little Street, from 4th north to 1st;
- 3rd Street, from Little east to Broadway;
- 3rd Street, from Andrick east to Arthur.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$308,020 to Marbery Concrete Inc. of Fort Scott. Weather permitting, the project should be completed by midsummer.
