## **KDOT to replace crossroad pipe on K-58 in Greenwood County**

**Thursday, March 3**, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to replace a crossroad pipe on K-58 in Greenwood County. K-58 will be closed to traffic at the work zone, which is one mile west of Lamont. **This project was initially scheduled to take place on Wednesday, March 2, but has been moved to Thursday in response to a forecast of possible inclement weather next Wednesday.**

KDOT maintenance crews from Eureka will complete the pipe installation between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic should find alternate routes around this closure on March 3.
