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
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K-66 bridge repair to begin July 8

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a bridge repair project on the eastbound lanes of K-66 at Riverton on Monday, July 8, weather permitting. The bridge is located ½ mile east of the U.S. 69A/K-66 junction.

Project activity includes: removal of the 1½ -inch polymer overlay from the bridge deck; partial- and full-depth patching; placing a concrete overlay on the deck; and replacing the bridge expansion devices.

The contractor will first install a permanent asphalt crossover on the median east of the bridge. Two-way traffic will be carried around the work zone on the new crossover and the existing crossover west of the bridge.



Two-way traffic will be carried around the K-66 bridge repair on two crossover sections.

KDOT awarded the \$1 million construction contract to Mission Construction Company, Inc., of St. Paul. The bridge work is expected to be completed by March 2020, weather permitting.
