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K-7 resurfacing project begins in Linn and Miami counties

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has begun a resurfacing project on a 12mile section of K-7 in Linn and Miami counties.

The mill and overlay project starts at the K-152 junction and continues north and west to U.S. 169.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone area during daylight hours; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. The resurfacing project should be finished in one month, weather permitting.

KDOT awarded the \$1.4 million construction contract to Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., of Topeka.
