Intersection improvements begin at Ottawa

The week of June 26 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) started a geometric improvement project to reconstruct the intersection of K-68 and Main Street at Ottawa. The intersection improvements also include new sidewalks, traffic signals, signs and pavement markings.

The intersection will remain open to traffic during construction, with lane closures. Pedestrian traffic should follow the sidewalk detours. Weather permitting, KDOT expects the project to be finished by mid-September.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$394,802 to Wildcat Construction Company, Inc., of Wichita.
