Roundabout west leg now open

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has opened the west leg of the roundabout being constructed at U.S. 59/U.S. 160. The north and east legs opened to traffic in mid-October. Construction continues at the south leg. The temporary road for east- and westbound traffic is being removed.

KDOT reminds drivers to obey the signs and pavement markings, and to slow down through the work zone.

LaForge & Budd Construction of Parsons is the primary contractor on the \$3.2 million roundabout project. Weather permitting, the roundabout should be finished and open to unrestricted traffic by December.
