## Sidewalk construction to begin in Humboldt

New sidewalks will be constructed along several streets in the city of Humboldt, starting the first week in March.

According to City Administrator Cole Herder, the first sequence of sidewalk construction will take place on 12<sup>th</sup> St. from Bridge north to Central. The first phase also includes sidewalk on Central from 12<sup>th</sup> St. west to 14<sup>th</sup> St. The second phase consists of new sidewalk on 11<sup>th</sup> St. between Bridge and Central, and on Central between 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> streets.

Pedestrians should use 11<sup>th</sup> St. as a detour for 12<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> St. as the detour for 11<sup>th</sup>. Weather permitting, the project should be completed by late April.

The \$139,000 project is part of the Safe Routes to School program. The contractor is Burlington Construction, Burlington. Persons with questions may contact the City of Humboldt, (620) 473-3232.
