U.S. 54 Bridge Repairs Continue in Meade County

The Kansas Department of Transportation will continue concrete deck patching on the US-54 bridge over Spring Creek in Meade County. Patching is scheduled to continue Monday, May 22, 2017 and continue for at least three days, weather permitting.

US-54 will be reduced to one lane guided by a pilot car during working hours with an approximate delay of 15 minutes during the project. The project is expected to be completed by Thursday, May 25, 2017, weather permitting. KDOT urges drivers to be alert, pay attention to all work zone warning signs, slow down when approaching a work zone and be prepared to stop.
