KDOT hosts public meeting on K-156 Hodgeman County project

The public is invited to attend an open house/public meeting for the K-156 project in Hodgeman County on Wednesday, Oct. 27, from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the King Center (312 Main Street) in Jetmore. The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) is hosting the event.

The meeting will provide an opportunity for citizens to view exhibits and maps of the proposed improvement, provide input and speak one-on-one with project staff. The K-156 Hodgeman County project will rehabilitate the existing pavement and add shoulders to about 15 miles of K-156 from four miles west of the U.S. 283 junction in Jetmore to 228 Road north of Hanston. This is one of five Modernization and Expansion highway projects in southwest Kansas that have been committed to construction as part of the Eisenhower Legacy Transportation Program (IKE). The project is in the IKE Construction Pipeline with the construction letting planned for fall of 2023.
