K-4 resurfacing and grading to begin in Ness County

Crews are expected to begin a grading and resurfacing project on K-4 in Ness County on Monday, June 7, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. The project will begin at the east city limits of Brownell and extend to the west city limits of Brownell.

A detour will be in place during the project. Westbound K-4 traffic will take U.S. 183 south to K-96, then K-96 west to U.S. 283 and U.S. 283 north to K-4. Eastbound K-4 traffic will take U.S. 283 south to K-96, then K-96 east to U.S. 183 and U.S. 183 north to K-4.

Morgan Brothers Construction of LaCrosse is the contractor on this \$1.2 million project, which is expected to be completed in November, weather permitting.
