KDOT pavement testing continues in southwest Kansas counties

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct pavement tests on highway sections in Finney, Hodgeman and Scott counties on Wednesday, Nov. 3, and Thursday, Nov. 4. Sections tested will include:

- U.S. 283 in Hodgeman County from K-156 to the Hodgeman/Ness county line;
- U.S. 83 from the U.S. 50/83 jct. in Finney County north to the Scott/Logan county line.

The KDOT testing crew will use a falling weight deflectometer to determine pavement strength on each section of highway. The deflectometer will be traveling with a crash attenuator at reduced speeds. Motorists should expect delays of 15 minutes or less.
