Survey work to begin in Ness County


Survey work for a proposed bridge replacement in Ness County is expected to begin Monday, June 7, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

The area being surveyed includes the Bazine Dry Creek bridge located on K-96 approximately 11.75 miles east of U.S. 283.

Chad Marsh with Kirkham Michael will lead this survey for the Kansas Department of Transportation.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
