Eastbound U.S. 50/400 to close in Kearny, Finney counties for railroad crossing repair

Department of Transportation

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be closing eastbound U.S. 50/400 starting Wednesday, June 1, until Monday, June 13. The closure is necessary to allow Pioneer Lines to replace the crossing and concrete pavement located 5 miles west of Garden City between North Sherlock and North Anderson.

The map below shows the approximate location of the closing. Signs will direct traffic to follow the signed detour on K-25, K-96 and U.S. 83. KDOT uses state highways for official detour routes for safety, weight and maintenance concerns. See the route outlined in blue on the map below.
