KDOT reminds public that US-50 open house is Thursday

The Kansas Department of Transportation will host a public information open house on Thursday, February 5, 2015, as part of a corridor study to determine future improvements to U.S. 50 from Dodge City to Kinsley. The open house, come-and-go format will give attendees an opportunity to provide input and speak one-on-one with project staff.

The study is looking at the need for passing lanes along the corridor, along with assessing the need for intersection improvements at Spearville. Other enhancements that might improve safety or traffic operations along the corridor will also be considered. This effort is for a study of this area only and will be complete in the fall of 2015. There is no funding for future construction at this time.
