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## Seal project to begin on U.S. 83 in Seward County

Crews are expected to begin a crack seal project on U.S. 83 in Seward County on Tuesday, Oct. 9. Work will begin at the Haskell/Seward County Line and go south to the K-160 junction.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. KDOT urges drivers to pay attention to all work zone warning signs, slow down when approaching a work zone and be prepared to stop.

Pavement Pros of McPherson is the contractor on this \$17,000 project which is expected to be completed by October 19, weather permitting.
