## Slope repair project planned on U.S. 283

The Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin work on a slope repair project along U.S. 283 in southern Norton County the week of Feb. 19, weather permitting.

Crews will be repairing and reinforcing the slopes at the North Fork Solomon River drainage bridge located approximately 1.4 miles south of the east U.S. 283 and K-9 junction. Traffic will be reduced to one lane at times and controlled by flaggers. Work is expected to be completed by the end of March.
