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## K-25 resurfacing project to start in Logan County

The Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin work on a resurfacing project on a portion of K-25 in Logan County on April 25.

Project work will involve milling and overlaying on 22 miles between 160<sup>th</sup> Road and the U.S. 40 junction. Traffic through the areas where crews are actively working will be directed by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should plan for delays of 15 minutes or less during daylight hours.

KDOT expects work to be completed in late June, conditions permitting.
