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Resurfacing on U.S. 40 Business in Geary County

The Kansas Department of Transportation has begun work for an HMA overlay on U.S. 40 Business in Geary County. Work will extend from Reynolds Street at the east city limits of Junction City to Canon View Drive, near westbound I-70 at exit 300.

A pilot car will direct one 12-foot lane of traffic through construction at reduced speeds. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Shilling Construction Co. Inc., of Manhattan is the primary contractor for this \$1.2 million project. The contractor has scheduled work to be completed in November, weather permitting.
