Lane closure on I-70 in Lincoln County begins Tuesday

On Tuesday, Oct. 20, the Kansas Department of Transportation will reduce eastbound I-70 to one lane in Lincoln County for emergency road repair. Work will occur approximately 7 miles east of K-156, at mile marker 231.

Construction will take place Monday through Friday with occasional Saturday work during daylight hours. Traffic will be reduced to one 16-foot lane at a reduced speed through the work zone. Drivers should expect minor delays, not exceeding five minutes.

Smoky Hill LLC., of Salina is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$43,000 project to be completed by November, weather permitting.
