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## **K-14 mill and overlay to begin in Ellsworth County**

On Monday, May 11, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a mill and overlay project on K-14, beginning from the Ellsworth city limits to I-70, approximately 7 miles.

Construction will occur during daylight hours, Monday through Friday, with occasional Saturday work. Traffic will be reduced to one 11-foot lane following a pilot car through the work zone. Drivers should expect a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

APAC Inc. of Hutchinson is the prime contractor and have scheduled this project to be completed in June, weather permitting, at a cost of \$1.5 million.
