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K-28 and K-148 crack seal in Jewell and Republic counties

On Thursday, March 26, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a crack seal operation on K-28 and K-148 in Jewell and Republic counties. Work will begin at K-28/K-14, continuing east on K-28 and K-148 to U.S. 81 for approximately 22 miles.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by flaggers at the location the contractor is actively working. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Pavement Pros of McPherson is the prime contractor and have scheduled this project to be completed by May 2020, weather permitting, at a cost of \$145,000.
