K-15 bridge replacement south of Washington

Work continues to replace the bridge over Mill Creek in Washington County. The bridge is located on K-15 just south of Washington.

A temporary traffic signal will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone. Please be aware that there is a lane width restriction of 12 feet and an oversize clearance restriction of 14 feet. Traffic should expect delays and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

This project is scheduled for completion in August 2020. Bridges Inc. of Newton is the prime contractor for this \$3.5 million project.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a work zone.
