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Resurfacing on K-18 begins today in Geary and Riley counties

On Wednesday, July 8, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a mill and overlay on K-18 in Geary and Riley counties. Work on K-18 will begin at the I-70/K-18 interchange in Geary County. Work will continue north about 3 miles to just north of the 12th Street interchange by Fort Riley in Riley County.

Traffic will be reduced to one 15-foot lane in each direction at the location the contractor is actively working.

Shilling Construction Co. Inc., of Manhattan is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$1.4 million project to be completed in early September, weather permitting.
