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## Highway project rescheduled in Marion and Chase counties

The Kansas Department of Transportation has rescheduled a project for a mill and overlay to begin on Monday, May 4, weather permitting. This project includes approximately 16.5 miles of K-150 from U.S. 77/U.S. 56 to U.S. 50 in Marion County and Chase County.

Work will occur during daylight hours with flaggers and a pilot car to move traffic through the work zone. Drivers should expect a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Cornejo and Sons LLC. Of Wichita is the prime contractor for this project at a cost of \$1.4 million in Marion County and \$1.6 million in Chase County. The contractor has scheduled this project to be completed in July, weather permitting.
