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## **Box Culvert Replacement on K-106 in Ottawa County**

As of Monday, January 13, 2014, K-106 will be closed for the replacement of box culvert located just south of the airport on K-106 between Minneapolis, KS, and K-18.

Southbound traffic will follow the detour signing and travel east from Minneapolis on K-106 to US-81 then south on US-81 to K-18 then west on K-18 to rejoin K-106 north. Northbound traffic will follow the same detour in reverse traveling south on K-106 to K-18 then east to US-81 then north to K-106 west into Minneapolis. Plans call for this project to be completed on or about Apr. 18<sup>th</sup> weather permitting.

The purpose of replacing the culvert is to improve drainage in the area while retaining the weight limit of the highway over Salt Creek.

Reece Construction Co Inc. of Scandia, KS is the prime contractor. Project cost is \$840,476.87.
