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### Bridge Replacement on K-266 in Republic County

Beginning Monday, Feb. 10<sup>th</sup> a project to replace a bridge on K-266 began. The project involves the removal of the bridge 1.98 miles north of the US-36/K-266 junction then construction a new bridge in its place. K-266 will be closed to traffic throughout construction. North bound traffic will be detoured 2 miles west on US-36 then 6 miles north on 30<sup>th</sup> Rd. then 2 miles east on Jade Rd. to rejoin K-266. South bound traffic will follow the detour in reverse. Plans call for this project to be completed on or about mid-May weather permitting. Because this project will occur during winter months the completion date for this project is flexible
