Survey Scheduled for I-135 overpass in McPherson County


Surveyors will soon be conducting work on The Ave. A. overpass crossing I-135 ¹/₂ mile south of the I-135/US-56 Interchange near the city of McPherson in McPherson County. The survey will extend 2000' east and west of I-135 along east Ave. A. The field survey is scheduled to begin November 30, 2015 and will be completed by December 25th weather permitting

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission prior to entering private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
