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Construction closes Spring Valley Rd in Junction City

Beginning Thursday, Sept. 10th, Spring Valley Rd. will be closed between Wildcat Lane and K-18. Traffic will be detoured around the project. K-18 traffic wanting to access Spring Valley Rd. south will follow the signed detour to US-77 then south to McFarland Rd then west to rejoin Spring Valley Rd. Spring Valley Rd. from K-18 north to Sutter Woods will remain open to traffic.

This first phase only is scheduled to be completed on or about Nov. 2nd weather permitting.

A planned list of improvements on US-77 as it passes through the Junction City area is under construction in phases. Projects to be completed in addition to the divergent Diamond Interchange at US-77/I-70 includes improvements to the Rucker Rd/US-77 Intersection, Spring Valley Rd between Rucker Rd and Sutter Woods Rd, a portion of Lacy Dr. and a continuation of the southbound US-77 climbing lane south of the K-57/K-24/US-77 intersection. The construction will be completed in several phases over the course of 3 years.

Ebert Construction Co. Inc. of Wamego, KS is the prime contractor.
