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## **Surveys Scheduled for US-24 in Mitchell County**

Surveyors will soon be conducting work on US-24 in order to gather information necessary for the detailed design of two proposed bridge replacements over Brown Creek 7.6 miles east of K-128 and Mulberry Creek 11.2 miles east of US-24 in Mitchell County. The surveys will take place 1/2 mile on each side of the bridge sites. Survey work is scheduled to begin Monday, October 5th and will be completed by the end of November weather permitting.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission prior to entering private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Kara LaRiviere, P.S., Field Survey Project Manager, will be in charge of this survey for the KDOT.
