## Survey on US-40B in Junction City

Surveyors will soon be conducting work on US-40B (Ash St.) in order to gather information necessary for the detailed design of a business route overpass over the UP Railroad and Monroe St., .2 miles east of US-77B (Washington St.) in Junction City. The survey will take place along a 3000 feet corridor beginning near Franklin St. then east to Filley St. The survey is scheduled to begin Monday, Sept. 14<sup>th</sup> and will be completed by mid-November weather permitting.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission prior to entering private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
