## **Survey on I-70 in Dickinson County**

Surveyors will soon be conducting work on westbound I-70 in order to gather information necessary for the detailed design of a proposed bridge replacement over Chapman Creek in Dickinson County. The survey will take place along a corridor .7 miles east-west of the present bridge. The survey is scheduled to begin Monday, Feb. 1, 2016, and will be completed by April 1<sup>st</sup> weather permitting.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission prior to entering private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
