K-15 Chip Seal in Clay & Dickinson Counties

Thursday, July 28, 2016, a chip seal project will begin on K-15 in Clay County ending in Dickinson County. Construction begins on K-15 at the south Clay Center city limit and will proceed south to the east K-15/K-18 junction in Dickinson County,

Traffic will be controlled by flaggers and pilot car at a reduced rate of speed during daylight hours only. A 15' lane width restriction is in effect. This project is scheduled to be complete by August 10th weather permitting.

The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the road and improve ride quality.

Mid-America Road Builders Inc. of Platte City, MO, is the prime contractor. Project cost is \$605,065.70
