## K-4 & K-104 overlays in Saline County (Update)

Wednesday, June 29, 2016, work begins on a three inch overlay to be applied to a portion of K-4 and K-104 in southern Saline County. The project begins at the K-4/Old 81 junction at Assaria then north to the K-4/K-104 junction continuing north then east on K-104 to the K-104/I-135 Interchange. The project will generally move from south to north. Initial work will involve patching along the route followed by the overlay of asphalt.

Traffic within the work zone will be controlled by pilot car and flaggers during daylight hours only.
