Sections of US-36/K-148 Highways to be overlaid in Washington County

Beginning, Monday, July 18, 2016, Traffic on selected areas of the 4-lane section of US-36 in Washington County will be restricted to the passing lane only in each direction for the overlaying of the driving lane in each direction. Traffic will be controlled by message board and traffic cones. There will be a reduced speed limit of 20 mph within the work zone.

K-148 from the K-148/K243 junction north to the KS/NE state line will also be receiving patching and areas of overlay. Traffic on K-148 will be controlled by flaggers and traffic cones.

Plans call for maintenance work to be completed on US-36 by July 22nd, and on K-148 by July 29th, weather permitting

The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the highways and improve ride quality.
