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US-77 work begins in Dickinson County

Construction activity on a US-77 project began yesterday, April 19, 2015. The project begins at the US-77/US-56 junction at Herington then north to the bridge carrying the highway over the Smoky Hill River near the Footlocker warehouse just south of the I-70/US-77 Interchange.

The purpose of the project is to mill $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch of asphalt from the road surface then overlay the highway with a 1.5 inch overlay sealing the highway.

Traffic is reduced to one lane of travel directed by pilot car. Drivers are advised to expect to stop approaching the work zone and wait for the pilot car to guide them through construction.

Hall Brothers Inc. of Marysville, KS is the prime contractor. Project cost is \$2,935,023.98
