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Light removal at U.S. 40 Business bridge in Geary County

Beginning today, the Kansas Department of Transportation is advising that the contractor will be removing streetlights in Junction City for the U.S. 40 bridge replacement, just east of Washington Street in Geary County.

Streetlights to be removed are located from Franklin Street to the eastern edge of the existing bridge. The lights will remain off until the new bridge has been complete in October 2023, weather permitting.

Streetlights located east of the existing bridge replacement are not being replaced and will remain on.

King Construction, Inc. of Hesston, is the primary contractor for this \$15.9 million project.
