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Resurfacing to begin next week in Dickinson County

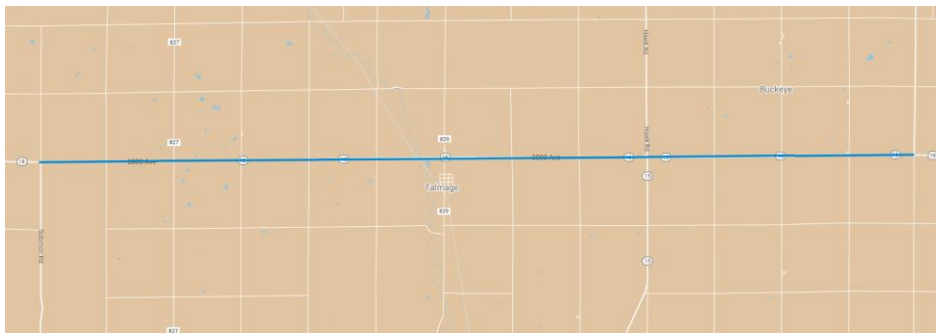
Beginning the week of Aug. 15, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a chip seal on about 13 miles of K-18 and K-15 in Dickinson County.

Work on K-18 will continue east from the Ottawa/Dickinson County line to the west K-15/K-18 junction. Work on K-15 will continue east from the west K-15/K-18 junction to the east K-15/K-18 junction. (See attached map.)

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through the construction zone. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Circle C Paving and Construction LLC. of Goddard is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$426,800 project to be completed by September, weather permitting.
