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Resurfacing to begin Thursday on U.S. 24 in Mitchell County

Beginning Thursday, July 21, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin resurfacing U.S. 24 from the Osborne/Mitchell County line east to the Mitchell/Cloud County line.

Work will occur Monday through Saturday during daylight hours. Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through the construction zone. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Dustrol Inc. of Towanda is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$3.6 million project to be completed by October.
