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Resurfacing project to begin on K-181 in Russell, Lincoln, and Mitchell counties

Beginning on Wednesday, March 30, the Kansas Department of Transportation will resurface approximately 37 miles of K-181 in Russell, Lincoln, and Mitchell counties.

Work on K-181 will begin at the K-232/K-181 junction in Russell County, continue east into Lincoln County and then extend north through Lincoln and Mitchell counties to the Mitchell/Osborne county line.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

APAC-Kansas Inc. of Hutchinson is the prime contractor for this \$6 million project which is scheduled for completion in May, weather permitting.
