Resurfacing to begin Monday on K-28 in Jewell County

Beginning Monday, July 18, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin resurfacing a portion of K-28 in Jewell County.

Work on K-28 will occur from the K-28/K-14 junction and proceed east about six miles to the K-28/K-148 junction in Jewell County.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through the construction zone. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Heft and Sons LLC. of Greensburg is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$178,813 project to be completed by August.
