Pavement patching begins Monday in Geary County

Beginning Monday, May 16, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin pavement patching on westbound and eastbound lanes of I-70 in Geary County. Work on I-70 will occur between K-57 and continue east about 15 miles to the Geary/Riley County line.

Temporary lane closures will reduce traffic to one 16-foot lane where the contractor is actively working. Drivers should expect minimal delays, not exceeding five minutes.

R A Knapp Construction Inc. of Lenexa is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$3.2 million project to be completed by October, weather permitting.
