Survey to begin Monday in Dickinson County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey on Monday, May 16 to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvements on K-15 in Dickinson County.

The location being surveyed are along the corridor on the existing highway alignment, located from the west K-15/K-18 junction and continuing east to the east K-15/K-18 junction.

KDOT estimates the survey to be completed by August 10. Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor.

A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property.
