I-70 closed in Lincoln County

I-70 in Lincoln County from mile markers 225 to 238 was closed to traffic at about 1:45 p.m. this afternoon due to a natural gas pipeline rupture.

Eastbound traffic is being detoured north on K-14, east on K-18 and south on U.S. 81 to I-70. Westbound traffic follows the same route in the opposite direction.

It is unknown at this time how long the closure will be in effect.
