Kansas celebrates 50th anniversary of I-70 completion

WHAT: Secretary Julie Lorenz will unveil signs celebrating the 50th anniversary of the completion of I-70 in Kansas and highlight the significance of the Interstate system across the country.

WHEN: **10:30 a.m. on Thursday, Aug. 20**

WHERE: **Kanorado motor carrier station on eastbound I-70.**
From westbound I-70, take the exit at mile marker 1 and KDOT staff will direct you to the event site.

In case of inclement weather, the event will be at the Goodland Travel Information Center, located on eastbound I-70, mile marker 7. From westbound I-70, take the exit at mile marker 1 and then go eastbound on I-70 back to the travel center.

Everyone attending the event must adhere to social distancing guidelines and must wear a mask.
