Anderson enjoys new role as KDOT Senior Director

Pam Anderson is settling into her new role at the Kansas Department of Transportation as the Senior Director of Administration.

“I am looking forward to continuing our efforts to serve the public while also finding ways to improve efficiency in our overall processes,” Anderson said.

Anderson has been at KDOT since 2005. She served in several roles in the Bureau of Fiscal Services and was promoted to Bureau Chief in 2020. Anderson was selected as the Director of Fiscal and Asset Management in late 2021, then was named Interim Senior Director soon after. Last fall, she was promoted to her new position, which joined the Fiscal and Asset Management Division with the Division of Administration.

In this role, Anderson oversees the bureaus of Finance and Budget, Fiscal Services, Human Resources, ADA/EEO/Employee Relations and Support Services, and the offices of Information Technology Services and Inspector General.

Improving procedures while also mentoring staff is important to Anderson. “My goals for the next few years are to do my part to help staff feel connected and be part of the KDOT family,” she said. “I want to make sure they understand how their job fits into the overall success of KDOT. I am committed to helping new managers achieve their goals by mentoring, answering questions and explaining why we do what we do.

Anderson and her husband have twin daughters. They are planning a big trip to Europe next year, which was previously cancelled due to Covid-19.
