## How to how to disable Compatibility View in Internet Explorer

If you do not see a search bar on the "KDOT Search Results" page, then you will need to apply the following steps below to fix this compatibility issue.

\*This compatibility issue is only known to affect Internet Explorer.

If you are using the Internet Explorer browser and click the "Search" tab (magnifying glass) on the header of the KDOT Internet page - <u>http://www.ksdot.org/</u> and your search page looks like this –
