K-15 (K-9) Speed Limit Lowered around Linn

After reviewing the results of a traffic study of the area and with the support of the community of Linn KDOT has resolved to reduce the speed limit from 65 to 55 mph beginning just south of the K-15/Horizon Circle intersection then north to a point just north of the K-15/1st St. /8th Rd intersection encompassing all four intersections providing access to Linn.

In addition to lowering the speed limit, KDOT will provide temporary speed trailers at each end of the reduced speed zone to assist motorists in adjusting to the 55 mph speed limit. KDOT anticipates the 55 mph signing will be posted and the speed trailers set in place by Friday, March 23, 2012, weather permitting.
