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Box Culvert Replacement Complete in Rooks County

The detour affiliated with a concrete drainage structure replacement project two miles west of Zurich on K-18 was discontinued May 18.

The official state detour signs, routing travelers around the project in Rooks County, were removed by construction crews. The project closed less than ½-mile of K-18 at the culvert location for approximately two months.

KDOT awarded this construction contract - totaling \$271,583 - to Reece Construction Co., of Scandia.

Subcontractors on the project included: Advanced Land Surveying & Drafting, construction staking, Hays; APAC Kansas, Inc., asphalt surfacing, Hays; Cillessen & Sons, traffic control, Wichita; Merz Bros. Construction, seeding and erosion control, Newkirk, Okla.; Thaxton Construction & Excavation, structure removal and grading, Salina.

The project was funded by T-WORKS, the transportation program passed by the Kansas Legislature in May of 2010.
